- ~Nancy Partridge, caretaker of the cemetery, will make a short presentation about the historic Baptist Church that was moved to the Granada Bridge.
- ~See antique muzzle loading muskets and a live firing of a Confederate mountain rifle (cannon) by the James F. Hull Camp 1347 Sons of Confederate Veterans.
